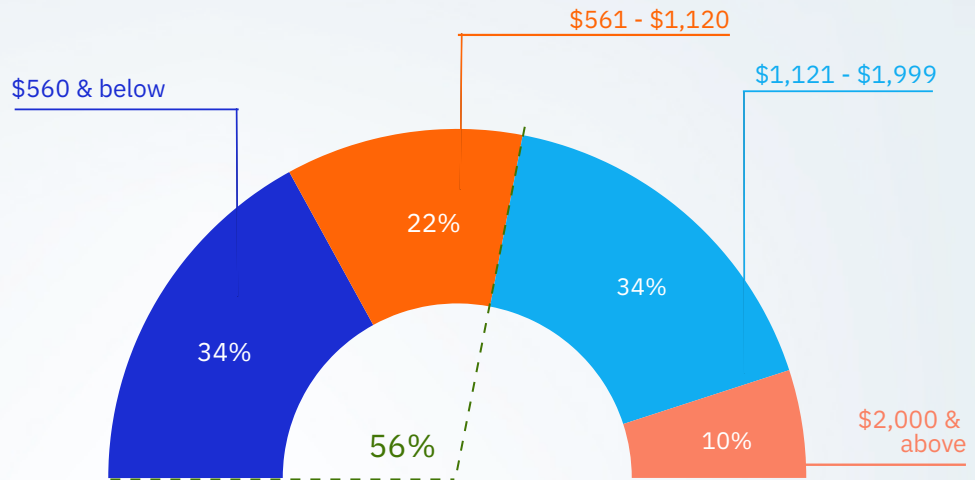

Based on application data

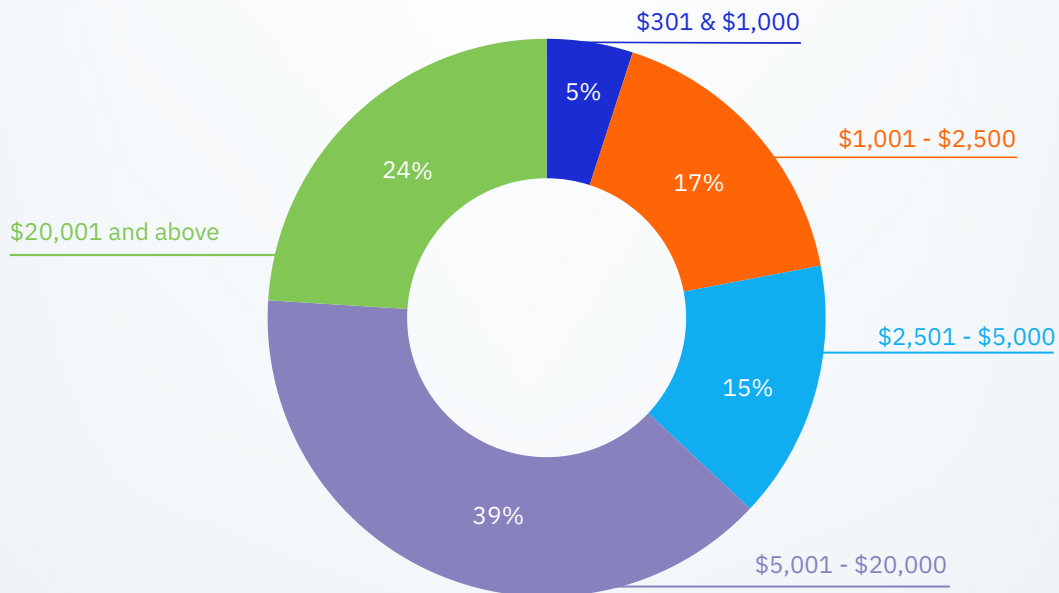
56% of applications come from the **lowest 20% PCI** of our community, measured by Department of Statistics (Household Income), 2021.

Small Gifts, Big Hearts

In 2024, 15 staff from the National University Heart Centre, Singapore (NUHCS) banded together to crochet items for a cause close to their Heart.

Over the span of 4 months, the NUHCS Electrophysiology Team, comprising doctors, nurses, medical technologists, case managers and administrative staff, tirelessly crocheted pouches and keychains to distribute as tokens of appreciation for donations made to the 'Small Gifts, Big Hearts' initiative. 100% of proceeds from the initiative was channelled towards the NUHCS Heart Fund, in support of financially disadvantaged Heart patients.

A continuation from its inaugural run in 2023, the 2024 'Small Gifts, Big Hearts' initiative was met with roaring success, raising a total of \$13,992 from 272 donors.
